Tips for Home Safety

Unfortunately there have been some recent home break-ins within our community. Please follow these tips to help avoid it happening to you.

1. Keep outside lights on at night.—A well lit home keeps the rats away.
2. Close all window coverings.—Keep prying eyes from seeing inside.
3. Install a random timer to vary times a light or radio is on while you are gone from your home.—If the time varies, it looks like someone is home. You can run it during the day also.
4. Have a neighbor watch your home and stop all mail and newspaper deliveries. – A pile of papers means you're not at home and check for things stuck on doors or door handles.
5. Place a stick in the sliding glass door channel to make it more difficult to slide open the door.—The more difficult it is to get inside, the more likely they'll go someplace else.
6. If you see something out of the ordinary or strangers milling around, call 911.

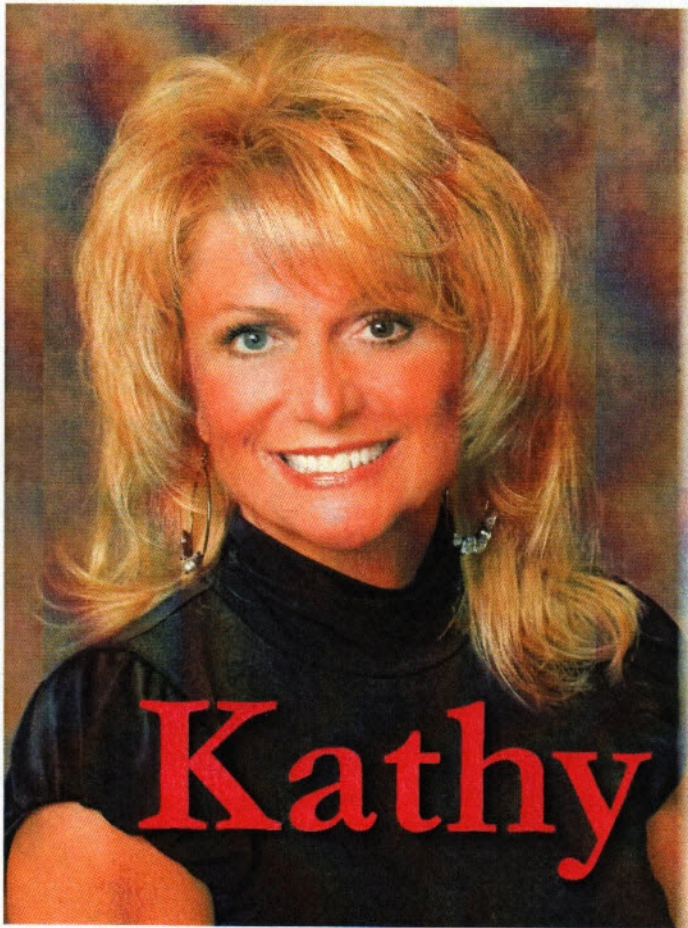
