HELP WANTED!!

Bloomfield Club is looking for help with grounds maintenance and general Club upkeep. We have a part time position open for a person to perform light maintenance and landscape care. Duties include weekly inspection of the grounds to determine which tasks need to be performed and if they can be handled in house or contract out. This person will learn the basics of our outdoor lighting, pond aerator, and irrigation systems to ensure that they are working properly and be able to perform light maintenance. Other tasks may include minor repairs and painting, regular clear out of the retention pond drain, and perennial plant care. This position is expected to require 1 day per week during the months of May through September and will report to the Club Administrator. Residents may apply.

Patio storage boxes may not exceed 48" in height, and 45 cubic feet in volume. Materials such as plastic bags, unused planting pots, and landscaping materials, including fertilizer and potting soil must be stored out of sight.
